- UCU represents our members in all sorts of OU forums. Are you worried about raising objections to management proposals? You can contact a UCU Rep to raise your views anonymously.
- Full membership is open to PhD students. It can be <u>free for up to 1 year</u>.
- UCU subscriptions are tax deductible.
