BURNOUT

Workload in higher education has been increasing for years, creating increasingly unmanageable pressure for staff across all categories. A 2021 workload survey from UCU found:

- 68% of staff reported that workload had increased significantly over the last 3 years
- 38% of staff reported their workload was unmanageable **most or all of the time.**

Those issues are reflected locally. The most recent OU staff survey found:

- More than 4 in 10 OU staff report an unmanageable workload (pulse staff survey)
- Overall, a shocking 44% of OU staff report stress-related pressure at work
- More than a third of OU staff report having more work than they can do well
- A quarter of OU staff report feeling undue pressure at work
- A third of OU staff report feeling that they have no control over their workload.

It's unsustainable.





THINGS MUST CHANGE

"For our members, obviously we do need a pay offer that deals with the cost-ofliving crisis and what's been a 25% pay cut since 2009; but our members are also incredibly concerned about **burnout workloads and the moral stain of casualisation** in our sector [...] It's about having lives and colleagues and workplaces that are full of people who are buzzing to be there, rather than **absolutely drained**."
